Day 1 (John 1:19-28)	Bethany beyond the Jordan: ► John testifies that he is the "voice of one crying in the wilderness" (Isa 40:3-5			
Day 2 (John 1:29–34; 1:29, "The next day")	Bethany beyond the Jordan: F John declares Jesus to be the Lamb of God and reflects on Jesus' baptism			
Day 3 (John 1:35–42; 1:35, "The next day")	Bethany beyond the Jordan: ► Jesus calls Andrew and Peter			
Day 4 (John 1:43–51; 1:43, "The next day")	Bethsaida: F Jesus calls Philip and Nathanael			
Day 5 (implied)	Cana of Galilee: F Jesus travels from Bethsaida to Cana			
Day 6 (John 2:1-11; 1:1, "The next day")	Cana of Galilee: ► Jesus changes water to wine			





<b>John 2:13</b> Now the Passover of the Jews was at hand,
and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. 14 And He found in the
temple those who sold oxen and sheep and doves, and
the money changers doing business. 15 When He had
made a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the
temple, with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out
the changers' money and overturned the tables. 16 And
He said to those who sold doves, "Take these things
away! Do not make My Father's house a house of
merchandise!" 17 Then His disciples remembered that
it was written, "Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up."




- 18 So the Jews answered and said to Him, "What sign do You show to us, since You do these things?"
- 19 Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."
- **20** Then the Jews said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?"
- 21 But He was speaking of the temple of His body.
- **22** Therefore, when He had risen from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this to them; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had said.
- 23 Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name when they saw the signs which He did. 24 But Jesus did not commit Himself to them, because He knew all men, 25 and had no need that anyone should testify of man, for He knew what was in man.

Matthew 4:12 Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. 13 And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, 14 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: 15 "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles: 16 The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned." 17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

 And the report about Him went out into every place in the surrounding region.

Mark 1:44 and He said to him, "See that you say nothing to anyone; but go, show yourself to the

Who can forgive sins, but God alone?" 22 But Jesus, aware of their reasonings, answered and said to them, "Why are you reasoning in your hearts? 23 "Which is easier, to say, "Your sins have been forgiven you," or to say, Get up and walk? 24 "But, so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins,"—He said to the paralytic—"I say to you, get up, and pick up your stretcher and go home." 25 immediately he got up before them, and picked up what he had been lying on, and went home glorifying God. 26 They were all struck with astonishment and began glorifying God; and they were filled with fear, saying, "We have seen remarkable things today."




